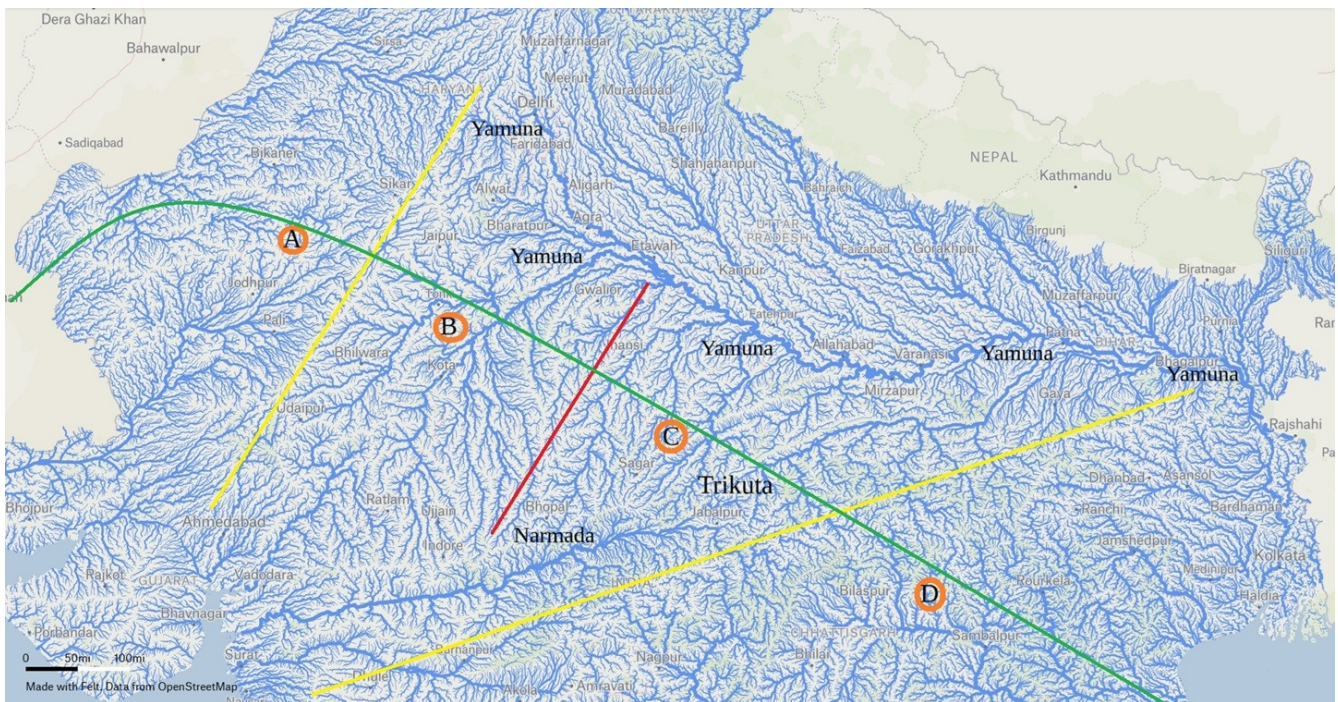


Peninsular India: An Archeological View

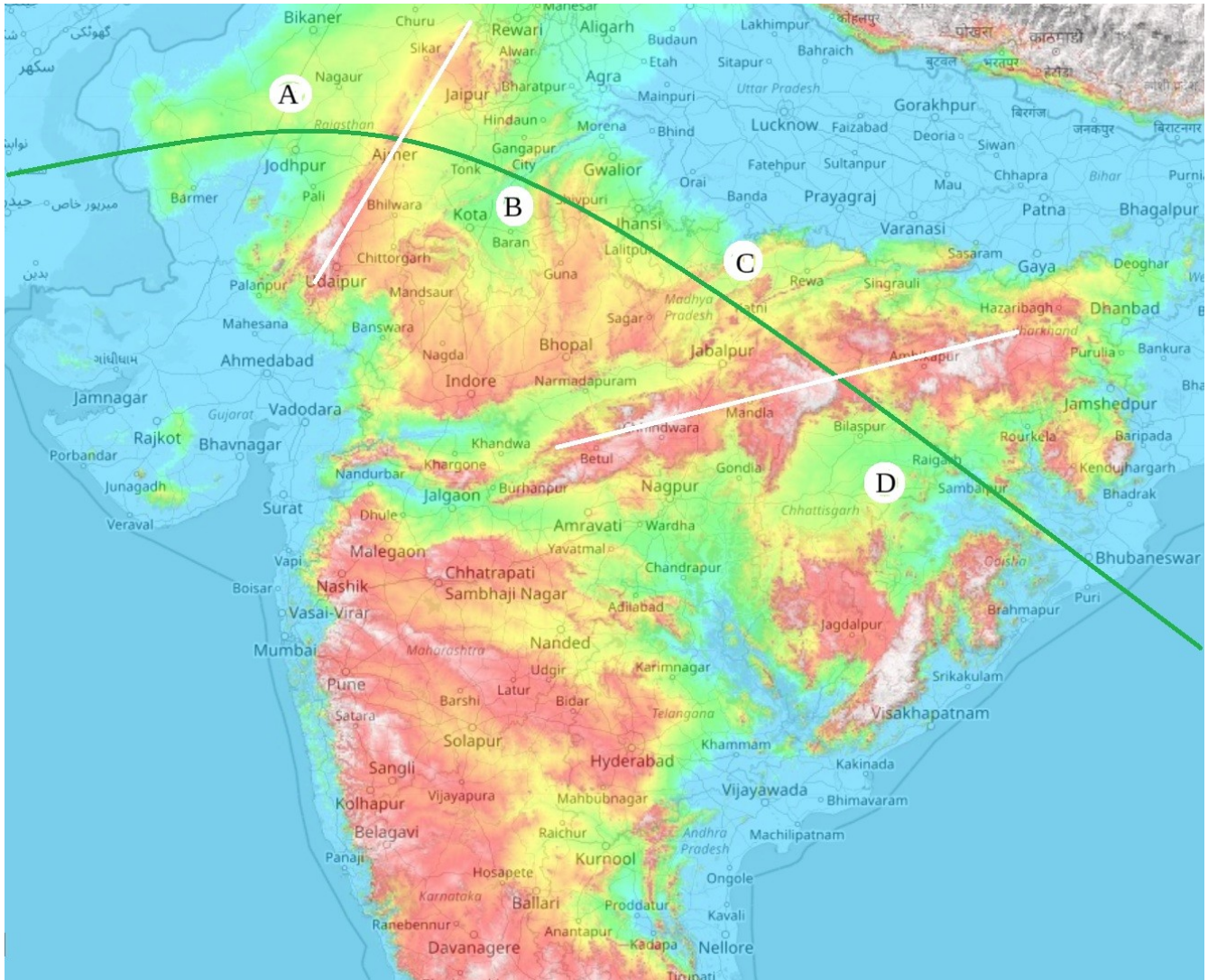

The unique geology of Peninsular India suggested an empirically verifiable hypothesis of human history that is both necessary and sufficient. Homo Sapiens evolved in Africa 200,000 years ago. Some of them moved to Ethiopia 100,000 years ago. In Ethiopia, they were split and moved in different directions. The Asian Homo Sapiens followed the monsoon winds from the Arabian Sea to the Bay of Bengal. They had nothing to do with the current Africans or Europeans. They evolved independently of the African and European Homo Sapiens. They were highly advanced logic-based Homo Sapiens.



The above is a map of Indian rivers. The two yellow lines are mountain ridges: Aravalli and Satpura. The green line is the path of monsoon winds. The red line is a marker of rain shadow. The land is divided into four sections: A, B, C, and D.

Every 20,000 years, monsoon winds changed their direction based on the Earth's rotation, called axial precession. When the winds blew from east to west, the east sides of the ridges (B) and (D) collected rainwater trapped by the ridges, and (A) and (C) were in the rain shadow, deprived of rainwater. Similarly, when the winds blew from west to east, the west sides of the ridges (A) and (C) collected rainwater trapped by the ridges, and (B) and (D) were deprived of rainwater. The areas alternated between fertile land and wasteland every 20,000 years, for millions of years.



The west sides of the ridges were fertile lands 20, 60, and 100 thousand years ago. They are now wastelands. Every 20,000 years, people were forced to move from fertile lands that turned into wastelands to wastelands that turned into fertile lands.

One hundred thousand years ago, the west sides of ridges were fertile lands. The Asian Homo Sapiens intuitively followed the monsoon winds to reach Peninsular India. They were highly advanced logic-based cultures, the cream. They had nothing to do with the African Homo Sapiens left behind. The Asian Homo Sapiens (Hindus) and Africans were separated 100,000 years ago. Hindus lived only along the path of monsoon winds in peace and tranquility for 100,000 years. Unfortunately, their cultures and history were deliberately destroyed by the European Homo Sapiens who moved to India via Bactria only 4,000 years ago.
