

Greeks in Rajasthan: An Archeological View

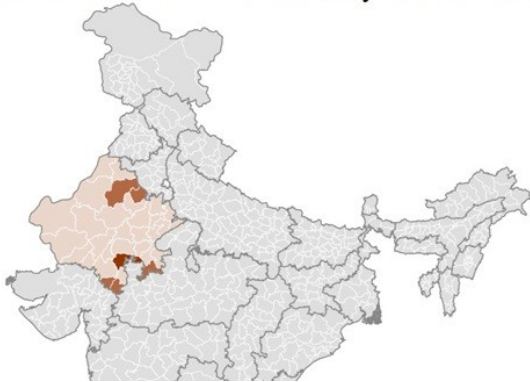

Before the Greeks moved to Nalanda, after the fall of the Gupta Empire, they lived in the northwest part of India that included the current Rajasthan and Pakistan. They were known as the Yavanas. The Greeks that lived in Kashmir were known as Kushans.

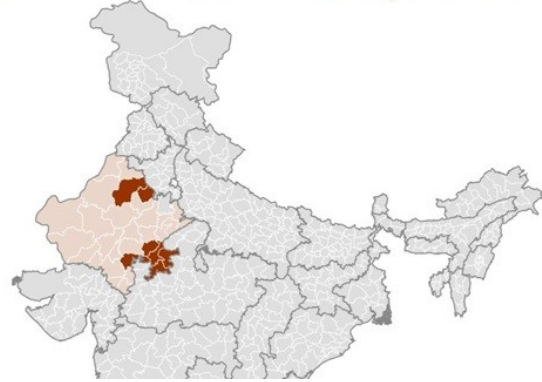
Brahmins were invented by the Kushans (Kanishka) out of the untouchable Avestan DNA Z93 refugees in Kashmir, who were kicked out of Avesta by Xerxes for their unethical and immoral social behavior of robbing people with fictional stories. Kanishka invented a synthetic language with artificial rules of syntax and grammar, called Sanskrit, for Brahmins to conceal their scandalous Avestan past. 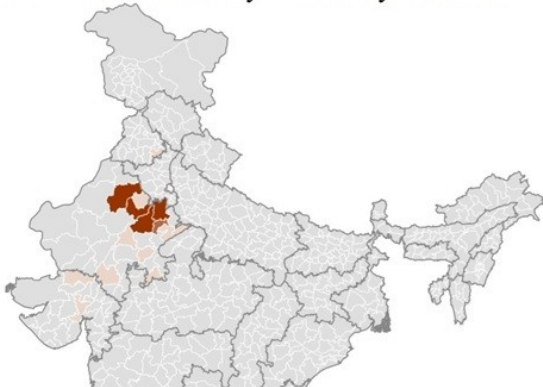
DNA Z93 Brahmin Trivedi density interactive map
